What: One-man exhibition featuring the sculptures of Peter Woytuk

Santa Feans have become accustomed to the three large bulls displayed at Plaza Resolana and have affectionately watched them come and go over the last several years. They are climbed on by children, photographed by tourists and mysteriously decorated by anonymous neighbors for various holidays. The sculptor, Peter Woytuk, has recently expanded the herd – now including five large bovines. They have traveled across the ocean from Thailand to be featured in his latest exhibition.

"Hens Revisited" will feature many of Peter's beloved animal creations – including bulls, sheep, ravens, roosters and hens, of course. Of particular note, Peter has designed a group of sculptures incorporating large rocks. He has combined these uniquely beautiful rocks with his bronze ravens, roadrunners, apples and tomatoes. The rocks jut out of the ground like dramatic monoliths, function as rustic benches or have been converted into naturalistic fountains – creating the perfect bases for Peter's whimsical birds and brightly patinaed fruit.
